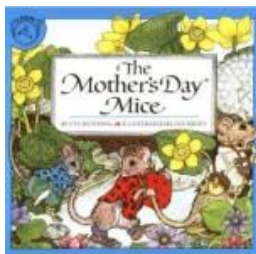

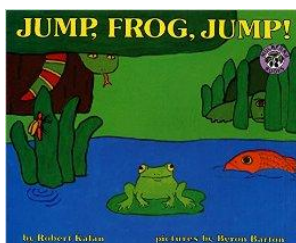

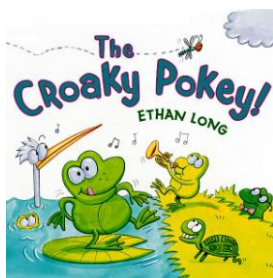

### Frogs

- Discuss the life cycle of a frog: Eggs, Tadpole, Froglet, and Frog.
