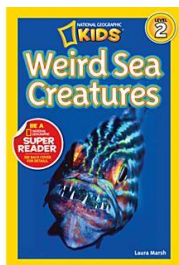
"Commotion in the Ocean" By: Giles Andreae

June Lesson Ideas: Ocean

- Create a graph of favorite ocean animals
- Construct an "ocean in a bottle"- First, fill a 2 liter bottle one third with water. Next, add several drops of blue food coloring and shake it up. Finally, fill the rest of the bottle up with vegetable oil and glue on the lid.
- Experiment with sink and float with objects in the room. Have the students predict which will sink vs. float. Leave the items in the water table for them to play on their own.
- Sing- "Ocean" (tune of Take Me Out to the Ballgame)-



- Hide shells with letters written on them in the sand table. Have students search for letters, make matches, and make the letter sounds.
- Read books about animals in the ocean to learn new facts (*Commotion in the Ocean* and *Weird Sea Creatures* are perfect for this)
